ON THE TILES

The Bisazza Foundation – the HQ of the Italian mosaic tile brand in Montecchio Maggiore, near Vicenza – has a cool new cultural space. Designed by architect Carlo Dal Bianco, it will showcase works and installations in mosaic by international artists and designers, among them Tord Boontje, Andrée Putman and Studio Job. There will also be temporary exhibitions – the first is by British architect John Pawson, who's creating his inaugural piece in mosaic especially for the show. VIENNESE WHIRL

Anyone heading for Vienna should check into the new Daniel hotel. Set in a 1960s landmark, it's quirky and fabulous, with clean, simple rooms in wood and concrete. Relax in a hammock or eat breakfast at the in-house bakery. From £76 per night (hoteldaniel.com).
